## Softball dinner, registration Feb. 3

The Bristol Girls Softball Little League will host its annual Pasta Dinner and Registration on Friday night, Feb. 3 from 5 to 8 p.m. at the Giamatti Cafeteria, 335 Mix St. Tickets are \$10 for adults, \$7 for children 3-12, and free for children under 3.

Bristol has one city-wide softball league for girls ages 5-18. Previously, Forestville, McCabe-Waters and Edgewood each supported its own softball division. In 2008, it was combined and a new league was chartered.

"The Bristol Girls Softball Little League as its own organization is able to focus resources on developing the girls' softball skills," stated League President Brian Bender in a press release.

Registration fees for the 2012 season are \$60 per child, with a maximum of \$125 per family. If registration is done online, it is \$62.50 per child.

At the pasta supper, the Bristol Girls Softball Little League will register players for the Tee-Ball, Minors, and Major levels of play. As a convenience for families, they may also register for girls softball at the various Boys Little League registration dates in January and February as well. Girls who register at other registration sites will receive a free ticket for the Feb. 3 Pasta Dinner.

"We have a fun night planned to get everyone excited for the upcoming softball season," stated Christine Champney in a press release. Champney is coordinating the pasta dinner. "In addition to a menu of pasta, meatballs, salad, bread, beverages and desserts, we will be having a raffle with lots of great items."
