If you cannot find the specific book you are looking for, special orders are available at no

charge with a wait time of about 3 to 4 days unlike the three to four weeks required by most big box stores. There is an extensive, well stocked children's section. In addition to books, the Noble Scholar also offers gifty-type items, cards and free gift wrapping to make one stop shopping a reality.
